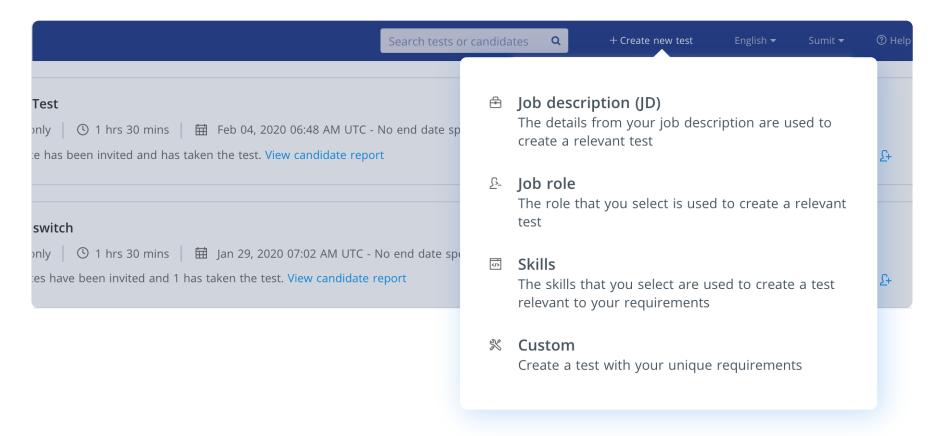

# **Cr**eating tests from a job description and job role

Recruiters and hiring managers are on the lookout to create assessments easily.

In addition to creating skill-based and custom tests, they can now create a test in two other ways using the HackerEarth platform.

a) By providing the job description

b) By choosing the job role.

## Creating a test from a job description

A job description or JD that contains the context of the job and responsibilities is used by most recruiters and hiring managers in the recruitment process. The simplest way to create an assessment is from a job description.

Simply upload or paste the job description and HackerEarth Assessments will create a test for you. Built on NLP, the platform extracts the skills and experience from the JD and creates an assessment best suited to evaluate a candidate. You can also add other relevant skills suggested by the platform, and edit details such as the test name and the job role.

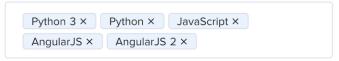

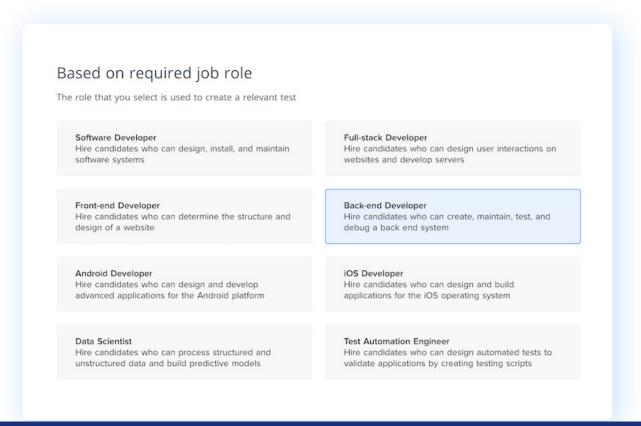
